WHEREAS, the proposed budget amendment was open for inspection by the public at a designated place; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and interested persons were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget amendment and any such objections were considered by Board of Directors; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the District shall and hereby does amend the budget for the fiscal year 2020 as follows:

General Fund \$30,000

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that such sums are hereby appropriated from the revenues of the District to the Debt Service Fund for the purpose stated, and that any ending fund balances shall be reserved for purposes of Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution.

Whereupon, a motion was made by Director Greenman and seconded by Director Ware, and upon a unanimous vote, this Resolution was approved by the Board of Directors.
